Registration Deadline: Please mail registration/waiver forms no later than April 14, 2009 *** [If you are registering after April 14th, please contact Lucia Peel at 252/798-3920 or director@roanokeriverpartners.org AND bring your registration form, liability waiver form and check with you on April 18th]

Check-in will begin at 7:30am on Saturday, April 18th in Windsor in the parking lot of Roanoke/Cashie River Center. Take-off times will be staggered beginning at 8:30am.

Route A: Hoggard's Mill – this leisurely route will have paddlers leaving the River Center and heading north on the Cashie to Hoggard's Mill Bridge and back. Great trip for children as it takes you through downtown Windsor. App. 3 hours with lunch at the River Center upon your return.

Route B: Johnson's Mill – this route is more strenuous and will have paddlers taking the out and back trip on the Cashie River to Johnson's Mill. App. 4-5 hours with lunch at the River Center upon your return.

Route C: San Souci or beyond – this route is for the Iron Men paddlers and the campers. Paddlers can paddle out to Sans Souci (app. 16 miles) and paddle back (this is for the Iron Men!) OR they may arrange transportation back from Sans Souci to the River Center (we will help with this as needed) OR paddlers/campers may continue on through the thoroughfare to the various camping platforms – Otter, Bear Run, Cow Creek, Cypress Cathedral, Three Sisters. Other intending to camp might wish to consider doing the Johnson's Mill trip and then driving from the River Center to Gardner's Creek for the short run out to Beaver Lodge or Barred Owl. Camping reservations must be made separately at www.roanokeriverpartners.org. All paddlers/campers taking this route need to make sure that the event planners are aware of their plans so we don't think you got swallowed up by a big bear! Lunch will be packaged so you can take it with you.

I hereby release, discharge and agree to save harmless the photographer, his representatives, assigns, employees from any liability as a result of any distortion, blurring or alteration, optical illusion or use in composite form, either intentionally or otherwise, that may occur or be produced in the taking, processing or reproduction of the finished product, publication or distribution of the same, even should the same subject me to ridicule, scandal, reproach, scorn or indignity.

Part B – Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement

I hereby release, waive, discharge and indemnify the Roanoke River Partners, the MidEast RC&D, the NC Paddle Trails Association, Bertie County/Windsor Chamber of Commerce, the Town of Windsor and the Roanoke Paddle Club, the owners of all property used in the event, volunteers offering ferrying from egress back to access points, and all other volunteers and save them harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, liability, costs and expenses in connection with loss of life, personal injury, and/or damage to property arising from or out of any occurrence associated with participating in or observing Paddle Days 2009.

I expressly acknowledge and agree that the activities at Paddle Days 2009 by their nature are dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I further agree that the foregoing release, waiver and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws governing the towns, cities, counties and states where this event is being conducted and that if any portion thereof is held as invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.

I have read and voluntarily sign the release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement and further state that no oral representations, statements or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

This release, waiver and indemnification agreement specifically embraces each and every phase of the event sanctioned, authorized, offered and/or promoted by said releasees during the entire event and applies to every activity and/or service of the event and has the same effect as if executed after each and every activity of the event in which I am participating so that the parties herein intended to be released and indemnified shall be fully and effectively released and indemnified as to the entire event.
